WATCH OUT FOR HUSSEIN DABAJA!

A man, identifying himself as Hussein Dabaja has struck again at a dealer in Western Ontario. He claims to own a dealership called Windsor Auto Exchange.

Neither Dabaja nor Windsor Auto Exchange are registered with OMVIC.

He purchases a vehicle and pays for it with a non-certified cheque. The cheque comes back NSF.

Police and OMVIC have been informed of the recent scam.

When dealing with dealers or salespeople you are not familiar with, insist on seeing a current OMVIC registration or contact the UCDA at 1-800-268-2598.
